Dear Spelmanite,

Congratulations! You've reached another milestone in your "journey to becoming a Spelmanite." You're ready to move into your residence hall. **Please note that you will be unable to move-in if you are not cleared medically and financially.**

To access our campus, please use the Lee Street entrance. A map and directions are on the *mySpelman* Portal. Your designated check-in time has been posted on the New Student Checklist and emailed to your Spelman email address. Please print and bring your move-in card with you so our security officers can direct you expeditiously to the Camille Olivia Hanks Cosby Academic Center to check-in. You can also use your phone to display it to gain access to campus.

On Wednesday, August 14th, you should

- Arrive on campus during your designated time period. You will be directed to park in a designated location.
- Walk onto the campus to the Camille Cosby Academic Center where you will check in at the Express Check-In Center. ***Your parents will be directed to the Manley Student Center where they will check-in and register for the Parent Association***
- Register for the Emergency Alert Information System
- Pick up your New Student Orientation packet.
- Come prepared to take and pick up your Id card (you will have it for the next four years)
- Reunite with your parents.
- Return to your vehicle and drive to your assigned residence hall.

We will process our last group of students beginning at 2:30 pm. If for any reason you are unable to check-in at the designated time, please call our New Student Orientation Hot-Line at 404-270-5701 as soon as possible so we can arrange your check-in after the Express Check-In Center closes. ***If you are unable to contact us regarding your late arrival on Wednesday, please plan to check in on Thursday morning beginning at 9:00 am in the Camille Cosby Academic Center.***

Additionally, the New Student Orientation and Parent Schedules are posted on the *mySpelman* Portal and the Spelman College website. Information is posted and updated daily, so check the Portal regularly. Also, the schedules are posted on the Spelman College webpage at www.spelman.edu. *You can also download the NSO Schedule to your smart phone by downloading Guidebook from the App Store or your cell phone's software provider by August 14th.* **As a reminder, please make sure you have completed the foreign language placement exam (unless you are interested in one of the languages not available online), new student survey, and the Ever-Fi modules.** Having these items completed ahead of time will expedite your move into the Residence Hall.

Remember to bring your move-in card, either printed or on your mobile device, which will ensure quick and direct entry onto campus. We look forward to greeting you on Wednesday, August 14th.
