My name is Sylvia D. Maddox and I am your Assistant Dean of Students at Spelman College. I hope that you are enjoying your summer and getting ready for your college transition.

Spelman College and other AUC institutions have partnered with EverFi, whose mission is to help students address critical life skills such as alcohol abuse prevention, sexual assault prevention and financial literacy.

As part of our comprehensive alcohol and sexual violence prevention program for new students, all incoming students will be **required** to complete AlcoholEdu, Transit, and Sexual Assault Prevention for Undergraduates. These online courses will provide you with information and feedback to empower you to make well-informed decisions about alcohol, help cope with drinking behaviors of peers, and explores key issues associated with sexual assault and relationship violence. The modules on sexual violence will also provide statistics, definitions and bystander skills and strategies.

Your login directions and additional details are included in this communication. Students are **required** to complete Part I of AlcoholEdu and Part I of Sexual Assault Prevention for Undergraduates before arriving for New Student Orientation. The program is accessible right now.

EVERFI has partnered with the National Domestic Violence Hotline to provide access to an anonymous “Chat with an Advocate” feature within this course. If at any time during the course you would like to chat with a trained Hotline advocate, you can click the "Chat with an Advocate" button. Advocates are available to chat every day from 7 a.m. - 2 a.m. Central Time. No identifiable information of learners using the chat feature will be collected by EVERFI nor shared back with Spelman.

- Enter the Registration Code: 7e58ba2e
- Click “I’m a Student” to create your EverFi Account
 - Note: When prompted, please enter your Spelman College 900 number to receive credit for completion.
 - Please make sure to select first year student or transfer student as appropriate
- **Complete Part 1 of AlcoholEdu, Sexual Assault Prevention for Undergraduates and Transit by August 1, 2019**

- After 45 days you will receive an invitation to complete Part 2 of AlcoholEdu, Haven and Transit which must be completed by September 15, 2019.

*If you already have an EverFi Higher Ed Account, go to <http://www.everfi.com/login>, enter your login information, then enter registration code 7e58ba2e by clicking “Add a Course” in the top right corner of the Dashboard.

Important Information

- You will need Internet access and audio capabilities.
- To avoid technical issues, please use any major web browser released within the previous two years.
- You may take the courses in multiple sittings.
- The courses may include surveys to help personalize your experience and measure students’ attitudes and behaviors. All survey responses are confidential; the school will only receive information about the student body as a whole and will never see individual students’ answers.
- Should you experience problems, technical support is available 24/7 and can be accessed from the “Help” link within the course.
- Spelman College STS will not be able to assist you with any technical issues with the Everfi course.
- If you neglect to complete the course, you will not receive your mandatory Olive Branch T-shirt and you will be required to meet with someone from the Dean of Students Office regarding your conduct.
